Specifically, Snohomish is a political subdivision of the State of Washington that operates on a not-for-profit basis on behalf of electricity consumers. Electricity consumers, not Snohomish itself, would obtain the ultimate benefits of any information provided in response to this request. Accordingly, disclosure of the information is not "primarily in the commercial interest" of Snohomish under 18 C.F.R. § 388.109(c)(1)(ii), but is in the interests of its electric ratepayers.
