

SUBJECT: Amendment to North Central Power Rate Schedule (AC-C800)

Reference: Defense Civilian Personnel Advisory Service, Wage and Salary Branch
memorandum, dated November 29, 2011, North Central Power Rate Schedule
(AC-C800)

The attached wage schedule amends the North Central Power Rate Schedule issued in the referenced memorandum. Sunday Pay (item 3) is amended to state: *"Employees who have a regular tour of duty which includes any of those hours falling between midnight Saturday and midnight Sunday shall be paid for each hour of regularly scheduled work, not to exceed eight hours, except when working under an AWS (compressed) schedule, at the basic hourly rate of compensation plus premium pay equal to 25 percent of the basic hourly rate. Overtime work on a Sunday will be paid 2 times the hourly wage rate."* The update in Sunday Pay is a direct result from the Memorandum of Agreement between the Government Coordinating Council #1, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW), and the Western Area Power Administration (WAPA). This MOA addresses AWS (compressed) work schedules for employees working on a Sunday. Due to Public Law 97-257, Sunday Pay was revised to reflect the changes in the Department of Interior and the Department of Energy's Sunday premium pay. There are no other changes to the schedule.

This authorization is effective on the first day of the first pay period beginning on or after April 8, 2012. Questions may be referred to Mr. Christopher Quesenberry at (703) 696-1742.

PREMIUM PAY

1. OVERTIME - Overtime will be paid at the rate of time and one-half for hours worked in excess of eight in one day or forty in one week (except as provided by sections 6121-6130 of title 5, United States Code). Required work in excess of 12 continuous hours shall be compensated at the rate of two times the basic rate of pay for all hours worked in excess of 12 hours. The double time rate shall continue until released.

2. HOLIDAY PAY - Hours of work performed on a holiday will be paid at the rate of triple time for the basic work requirement. Work on holidays in excess of the basic work requirement will be paid the overtime rate of double time.

*3. SUNDAY PAY - *Employees who have a regular tour of duty which includes any of those hours falling between midnight Saturday and midnight Sunday shall be paid for each hour of regularly scheduled work, not to exceed eight hours, except when working under an AWS (compressed) schedule, at the basic hourly rate of compensation plus premium pay equal to 25 percent of the basic hourly rate.* Overtime work on a Sunday will be paid 2 times the hourly wage rate.


4. SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL - None.

5. EXPLOSIVES HANDLING PAY - Explosives handling pay will be paid at the rate of an additional 25% of the base hourly rate of pay when officially assigned to handle explosives.

6. FIREFIGHTING PAY - Firefighting pay will be paid at the rate of an additional 25% of the base hourly rate when officially assigned as a participating member of a fire fighting crew in fighting fires of equipment, installations, and buildings, or when fighting forest and range fires on the fireline.
