#### PREMIUM PAY

- 1. OVERTIME Overtime will be paid at the rate of time and one-half for hours worked in excess of eight in one day or forty in one week (except as provided by sections 6121-6130 of title 5, United States Code). Required work in excess of 12 continuous hours shall be compensated at the rate of two times the basic rate of pay for all hours worked in excess of 12 hours. The double time rate shall continue until released.
- 2. <u>HOLIDAY PAY</u> Hours of work performed on a holiday will be paid at the rate of triple time for the basic work requirement. Work on holidays in excess of the basic work requirement will be paid the overtime rate of double time.
- 3. <u>SUNDAY PAY</u> Hours of work performed on a regularly scheduled Sunday will be paid an additional 25% of the base hourly rate for each hour worked. Work on a regularly scheduled Sunday in excess of the basic work requirement will be paid the overtime rate of double time.
- 4. SHIFT DIFFERENTIAL None.
- 5. <u>EXPLOSIVE HANDLING PAY</u> Explosives handling pay will be paid at the rate of an additional 25% of the base hourly rate of pay when officially assigned to handle explosives.
- 6. <u>FIREFIGHTING PAY</u> Firefighting pay will be paid at the rate of an additional 25% of the base hourly rate when officially assigned as a participating member of a fire fighting crew in fighting fires of equipment, installations, and buildings, or when fighting forest and range fires on the fireline.
