## REQUEST FOR PRIOR APPROVAL OF CAPITAL EXPENDITURES OVER \$5,000 PER UNIT AND/OR ALTERATIONS TO REAL PROPERTY FINANCED WITH HAVA FUNDS

All capital expenditures over \$5,000 per unit must be approved by the U.S. Election Assistance Commission (EAC) prior to purchase except for purchases of voting systems and capital expenditures related *solely* to the implementation of the statewide voter registration list. All alterations to real property, including remodeling of office space, must also be approved by EAC prior to purchase. The requirements for preapprovals are contained in Office of Management and Budget Circular A-87, *Cost Principles for State, Local, and Indian Tribal Governments.* Please refer to the Frequently Asked Questions available on EAC's website at <a href="https://www.eac.gov">www.eac.gov</a> for a description of appropriate uses of Help America Vote Act (HAVA) funds and an in-depth explanation of allowability, allocability, and reasonableness of costs paid for with HAVA funds.
