A. <u>Mission Description and Budget Item Justification</u>

The RDT&E funds contained in the DSS budget are administered by the Department of Defense Polygraph Institution These funds provide grants for master's and doctoral degree students and funding to academic and private in research in forensic psychophysiology. Additionally, funds provide for external contracts for projects the porated in the Institute's prioritized research plan. This plan was developed at the request of the Secur Board. The research program has three Congressionally mandated research areas: (1) evaluate the validity polygraph techniques, (2) conduct research on polygraph countermeasures, and (3) conduct developmental research to improve polygraph technology. Research falls into four major categories:

(1) computerization of polygraph test resuts, (2) new physiological measures and equipment, (3) new test for and procedures, and (4) miscellaneous grants to construct a computerized data base that contains studies and statistics on polygraph studies.
