Laptop Security

Your laptop always TRAVELS with you.

Take your laptop out of the case.

Using your computer case to carry your laptop may advertise what's inside. Use a suitcase or backpack instead.

Remember your password.

Leaving passwords in your laptop bag or on your laptop itself is like leaving the keys in your car.

Awareness in the airport.

Keep your eye on your laptop, especially as you go through security. Once you're on the plane, be aware of your surroundings and remember to double check the seat-back pocket before you exit!

Vehicles are not safe storage.

Never leave your laptop in the car—not on the seat nor in the trunk.

Encrypt your data.

Make sure to use approved encryption technology.

Lock it.

No matter where you are, always secure your laptop. Attach it to immovable objects, like a heavy piece of furniture, or store it in the hotel safe when traveling.

Stove it off the floor.

No matter where you are in public, do not put your laptop on the floor. If you must put it down, place it between your feet so you are constantly aware of its presence.

Carry your laptop like you would carry your cash.
