Features:
$\diamond$ Dark rosettes (six or more dark spots surrounding a central point) on back
$\diamond$ Rows of spines along back and tail
$\diamond$ Tail rather long

## Little Skate



Alternative name: Summer Skate

## Common Skate

Range: Gulf of St. Lawrence,
Canada to NC, USA
Depth: 0-50 fth ( 90 m )
Max. size: 21in ( 54 cm )
Features:
$\diamond$ Rounded disk
$\diamond$ Two rows of spines on either side of the middle of tail
$\diamond$ In males ( $35-50 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) claspers extend well beyond back edge of disk.
$\diamond$ In female (35-50 cm) patches of spines located on both sides of anus

## Winter Skate



Alternative name: Big Skate Spotted Skate Eyed Skate
Range: Newfoundland, Canada to
North Carolina, USA
Depth: 0-50 fth ( 90 m )
Max. size: 43 in ( 109 cm )

## Features

$\diamond$ Rounded disk
$\diamond$ Two rows of spines on either side of the midline on tail.
$\diamond$ In males $(35-50 \mathrm{~cm})$ claspers barely (if at all) reach edge of posterior disk.
$\diamond$ In females ( $35-50 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) no rough patch on sides of vent

## Smooth Skate-PROHIBITED



Alternative name: Prickly Skate Smooth Tailed Skate
Range: Newfoundland, Canada to South Carolina, USA
Depth: 25-500 fth ( $45-900 \mathrm{~m}$ )
Max. size: 24 in $(61 \mathrm{~cm})$
Features:
$\diamond$ Nose pointed
$\diamond$ Row of many small spines on top from tail to behind eyes
$\diamond 2$ additional rows of small spines along each side of tail

## Clearnose Skate



Alternative name: Brier Skate Range: MA to FL, USA
Depth: 0-180 fth ( 330 m )
Max. size: 37 in ( 94 cm ) Features:
$\diamond$ Bars and spots on top surface
$\diamond$ One line of thorns that run down the mid-line of back Large clear space on each side of snout
$\diamond$ Defined space between two dorsal fins on tail

## Thorny Skate-PROHIBITED



Alternative name: Starry Skate Mud Skate
Range: Greenland to South Carolina, USA
Depth: 10-545 fth (20-1000 m)
Max. size: 40 in ( 102 cm ) Features:
$\diamond$ Regular row of 13-17 large thorns along middle back
$\diamond$ Rough top surface with thorns scattered over disk and tail
$\diamond$ Tail shorter than body
$\diamond$ Large thorns on shoulders

Barndoor Skate-PROHIBITED


Range: Newfoundland, Canada to North Carolina, USA
Depth: 0-235 fth ( 430 m )
Max. size: $5 \mathrm{ft}(152 \mathrm{~cm})$
Features:
$\diamond$ Very pointed nose, front edges of disk concave
$\diamond$ Distinct gray coloration on bottom
$\diamond$ Three rows of spines on tail
