## Dear Mack:

We hope this letter finds you well. You are to be congratulated on your many successes within the first nine months in office. From our vantage point, you and the Administration are well on the way toward implementing your game plan on controlling the deficit, NAFTA, and health care reform.

As you are aware, we at Anheuser-Busch began implementing a plan to help reduce alcohol abuse in the U.S. in 1983 and have spent well over \$100 MM through 1993. We are proud that our efforts have played a role in the continuing decline of alcohol abuse in the country over the last decade. As an ongoing part of those efforts, we met with Dr. Elders in Arkansas prior to her confirmation as Surgeon General. At that time, we believed that we and Dr. Elders shared the same goals of reducing drunk driving and other forms of alcohol abuse, as well as the further development of programs to educate parents on ways to discuss alcohol with their children, and other ways to help young people make responsible choices. We were encouraged that Dr. Elders appeared to be inclined not to follow the lead of her most recent predecessor in either depicting all drinking as bad or in attempting to cast our industry as the source of problems.

In now appears, however, that Dr. Elders is taking a decidedly anti-industry position, as well as one that is counter to that of the Administration, with respect to alcohol excise taxes as a source of funding for health care reform.
