

Special Diabetes Program for Indians Healthy Heart (HH) Initiatives by IHS Area

The 30 Healthy Heart (HH) Initiatives received funding in 2010 and use an intensive clinical, team-based, case management approach to treat risk factors for cardiovascular disease in people with diabetes. These programs build on the best practices from the original HH Demonstration Projects which ended in 2009, and incorporate the latest cardiovascular disease prevention clinical guidelines.
