

Anatomy of an ARC Series Description

Example ARC Search Results: Hit #1 of 65
65 hit(s) retrieved for keywords "nasa" with filters applied.

The Title is the name assigned to the records. It explains what they are. Here, we have letters, or correspondence.

The ARC Identifier number is unique. You could put 606261 in the ARC keywords search box to retrieve this one description.

The Creator made or organized the records. Here, it is a division of NASA. Sometimes, there are several creators.

Location info tells you where the records are kept and how to get in touch with the staff there. This series is at Fort Worth, TX.

Inclusive Dates tell you when the creator made these records. Here, NASA created these letters between 1967 and 1970.

Level of Description tells you if you are reading about a Record Group, Collection, Series, File Unit, or Item. Here we have a Series in Record Group 255.

Scope and Content Note explains what the records are and what they're about. This series is letters sent and received by a part of NASA.

Levels in ARC:

- Record Groups and Collections contain Series.
- Series contain File Units or Items.
- File Units contain Items.
