## Summary File 1 has 4 different Table Types:

- Detailed Table - Tables from summary files that provide the most detailed data on all topics and geographic areas from the decennial censuses
- Quick Table - Predefined tables with frequently requested information for geographic areas.
- Geographic Comparison Table - Predefined tables that provide basic measures for population and housing subjects. Users can compare data across geographic areas in the same table (e.g., all counties in a state).
- Geographic Header - Provides the GEO codes for the Summary File. It is used in GIS work.

Note: Once a Product Type has been selected, the number of search results will be reduced.
