- Similar content as Census 2000 Summary File 1
- 2010 2000 Crosswalk



Summary File 1 Table Numbers

- "P" tables: Population Subjects available down to the block level
- "PCT" tables: Population Subjects available down to the census tract level
- "PCO" tables: Population Subjects available down to the county Level
- "H" tables: Housing Subjects available down to the block level
- "HCT" tables: Housing Subjects available down to the census tract level



Age and Sex



- Single years of age under 20 (P14) block level
- Single years of age up to 99, 100-104, 105-109, 110+
 (PCT12) tract level
- Householders: 10-year age groups (P22) block level
- Group Quarters Population: Under 18, 18-64, 65+
 (P43) block level
 - 24 Group Quarter categories (PCT21) tract level



Race and DETAIL! Hispanic or Latino Origin

- Detailed American Indian and Alaska Native tribes, Asian, Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and Hispanic or Latino groups (PCT1-PCT11) – tract level
- Selected tables iterated by:
 - A. White alone
 - B. Black or African American alone
 - C. American Indian and Alaska Native alone
 - D. Asian alone
 - E. Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone
 - F. Some Other Race alone
 - G. Two or More Races
 - H. Hispanic or Latino
 - I. White alone, not Hispanic or Latino



Race and DETAIL! Hispanic or Latino Origin

- PCT 12 shows single years of age by sex census tract level:
 - J. Black or African American alone, not Hispanic or Latino
 - K. American Indian and Alaska Native alone, not Hispanic or Latino
 - L. Asian alone, not Hispanic or Latino
 - M. Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander alone, not Hispanic or Latino
 - N. Some Other Race alone, not Hispanic or Latino
 - O. Two or More Races, not Hispanic or Latino

- Presence of unmarried partner of householder census tract level:
 - Same sex unmarried partner and opposite sex unmarried partner (PCT15 and PCT17)
 - Own and related children under 18 years old (PCT15)

- Own children (P19) and related children under 18 years old (P21) – block level
- People under 18 years, 60+, 65+, 75+ (P20, P24 –
 P26) block level
- Nonrelatives (P27) block level
- Household size (P28*) block level
- Average household size (P17*) block level

Families



- Average family size (P37*) block level
- Family type by presence of
 - Own children under 18 years old (P38*) –
 block level

Group Quarters Population

- Advance Group Quarters File block level identical to P42 in SF 1:
 - Correctional facilities for adults
 - Juvenile facilities
 - Nursing facilities/Skilled-nursing facilities
 - Other institutional facilities
 - College/University student housing
 - Military quarters
 - Other non-institutional facilities
 - Crossed by sex and broad age groups (P43) block level
 - 24 group quarters categories, by sex and broad age groups (PCT20* and PCT21) – census tract level

Group Quarters Population by Sex by Age DETAIL!

- Group quarters population by sex by 5-year age groups (PCO1) county level
- Repeated for: county level
 - Institutional facilities by sex by age (PCO2)
 - Correctional facilities for adults by sex by age (PCO3)
 - Juvenile facilities by sex by age (PCO4)
 - Nursing facilities/skilled-nursing facilities by sex by age (PCO5)
 - Other institutional facilities by sex by age (PCO6)
 - Noninstitutional facilities by sex by age (PCO7)
 - College/University student housing by sex by age (PCO8)
 - Military quarters by sex by age (PCO9)
 - Other noninstitutional facilities by sex by age (PCO10)



Housing Units



- Race/Hispanic origin of householder (H7) block level
 - by tenure (H14) block level
- Race responses tallied (H8 and H9) block level
- Tenure (owned or rented) by
 - Household size (H16*) block level
 - Age of householder: 10-year age groups (H17*) block level
 - Household type by broad age groups of householder (H18) – block level
 - Presence of people under 18 (H19) block level



Step – 1: Make "Your Selections"




From the Main page:



Step – 3: Review Your Selections




- "Your Selections" and your "Search Results" are updated.

Step – 4: (Optional) Select Geographies

Select "Geographies"

- The Geographies Search overlay window displays
- Your Search Results remain behind the overlay
- Use the Geography Name text search option or Geography Filter Options to select Geographies






Step – 4: (Optional) Select Geographies

EXAMPLE: Select "All Counties in Hawaii"

- Use the Geography Filter
 Options to select "Your
 Geography Filters"
 - Select the Geographic Type "County"
 - Your Geography Filters
 & Geography Results
 are updated
- Select "All Counties in Hawaii"
 - Close the Geographies
 Search overlay window
 - "Your Selections" &
 "Search Results" are
 updated





Step – 5: (Optional) Select Your Product Type:



Summary File 1 has 4 different Table Types:

- **Detailed Table** Tables from summary files that provide the most detailed data on all topics and geographic areas from the decennial censuses
- **Quick Table** Predefined tables with frequently requested information for geographic areas.
- **Geographic Comparison Table** Predefined tables that provide basic measures for population and housing subjects. Users can compare data across geographic areas in the same table (e.g., all counties in a state).
- **Geographic Header** Provides the GEO codes for the Summary File. It is used in GIS work.

Note: Once a Product Type has been selected, the number of search results will be reduced.







Step – 6: Select & View Products



Select the Summary File 1 table from the Search Results list:


 Click on the hyperlinked table Title to view the table

- **Note:** Use the Download option to download the table in a database compatible format from the Search Results page.



Step – 6: Select & View Products

 - **Create Map** (only applies when you have 2 or more "like" geography types selected (i.e., 2 or more counties, 2 or more states, etc.)


