


Figure 1. Aerial photograph showing the relative location of MO-493 as well as the proposed construction area that will be utilized to perform the described renovation work scope.




Figure 5. Aerial photograph showing the relative location of MO-531 as well as the proposed construction areas around the trailer that will be utilized to perform the described renovation work scope.
