 The TPA was approved by OGC and it is now awaiting approval from the Department of Acquisitions and Grants Management (DAGM).
 Legal issues are being considered by DAGM. Anytime you sign an agreement, it becomes a legal document. The TPA and BAA have two distinct purposes. The BA is a legal and binding contract. The TPA provides a standard transactions framework between the trading partner and the area/site.
 The TPA will be posted to the IHS website as soon as one becomes available. All TPAs should be reviewed by area/site OGC.

 3rd Party Billing v2.5, Patch 4 looks good. No errors reported. Goes out Friday 12/12 or Monday, 12/15.
 Good news! Release candidate – PIMC said they'll go live with Patch 4 on 12/11: Sells 12/15, Santa Rosa and Santa Xavier on 12/23.
 Patch 4 has fixes for Trailblazer Medicare, Part A&B, and AHCCCS 837I,P,D.
 835 had (11) files filed into the Accounts Receivable files (Medicare Part A) at Tuba City.
