





Annual U.S. Natural Gas Consumption by Sector




U.S. Natural Gas Consumption for Power Generation




Total U.S. Natural Gas Demand (All Sectors) and Temperatures




Atlantic Basin European and US Spot Natural Gas Prices




Henry Hub Natural Gas Daily Spot Prices, 2001-2011






Canadian and LNG Natural Gas Imports Into the U.S.






Monthly Gas Imports at Existing U.S. LNG Facilities




Daily Gas Sendout from Existing LNG Facilities



World LNG Estimated November 2011 Landed Prices




Monthly U.S. Dry Gas Production – Lower 48 States




Total U.S. Working Gas in Storage




Regional Totals of Working Gas in Storage



U.S. and Canadian NG Drilling Rig Count and Daily Spot Prices




U.S. Oil and Natural Gas Drilling Rig Count by Type





Natural Gas Storage Inventories - September 23, 2011


