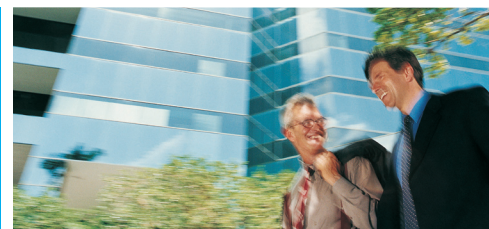

Portfolio Manager

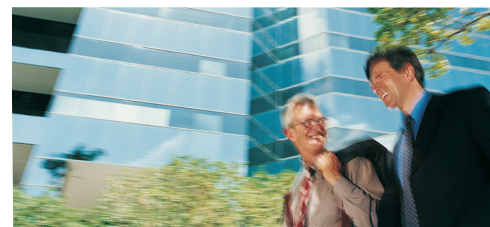
