To Parties Interested in the NLSL Adjustments to the FY 2002-2008 ASC Estimates:

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) is opening a 2-week comment period to receive feedback on New Large Single Load (NLSL) determinations and adjustments to its FY 2002-2008 Average System Cost (ASC) estimates to be used in BPA's WP-07 Supplemental Proceeding.

In accordance with section 5(c)(7)(A) of the Northwest Power Act, BPA must exclude from ASCs the cost of additional resources in an amount sufficient to serve any new large single load of the utility. As part of the ASC Methodology Expedited Process, utilities were required to provide BPA load data from 1993-2007 for the purpose of identifying NLSLs. Because BPA and exchanging utilities have implemented Residential Exchange Program (REP) settlements since 1996, utilities did not file NLSL information with BPA during that period. BPA has analyzed the data provided by utilities intending to participate in the REP beginning October 1, 2008, and has made NLSL estimates used in calculating the utilities' respective FY 2002-2008 ASCs. Enclosed is the analysis which shows the identified NLSLs, the resource costs associated with serving such loads, and the resulting ASC adjustments, if any.

Due to the confidential nature of the NLSL load data, BPA has only provided annual loads. If any party wishes to come to BPA to review the data in greater detail, subject to confidentiality requirements, please contact me at 503-230-5858 or mlmanary@bpa.gov.
