 - 4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

ation of the bill (H.R. 2273) to amend subtitle D of the 1 2 Solid Waste Disposal Act to facilitate recovery and bene-3 ficial use, and provide for the proper management and dis-4 posal, of materials generated by the combustion of coal 5 and other fossil fuels. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-6 7 ation of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-8 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-9 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority 10 member of the Committee on Energy and Commerce. After general debate the bill shall be considered for 11 12 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order 13 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-14 15 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce now printed in the bill. The com-16 17 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be 18 considered as read. All points of order against the com-19 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amendment to the committee amendment in 20 21 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those 22 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-23 panying this resolution. Each such amendment may be of-24 fered only in the order printed in the report, may be of-25 fered only by a Member designated in the report, shall

be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time spec-1 2 ified in the report equally divided and controlled by the 3 proponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-4 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division 5 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the 6 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are 7 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for 8 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill 9 to the House with such amendments as may have been 10 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of 11 12 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in 13 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be 14 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto 15 to final passage without intervening motion except one motion to recommit with or without instructions. 16
