## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4281) to provide an extension of Federal-aid highway, highway safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other programs funded out of the Highway Trust Fund pending enactment of a multiyear law reauthorizing such programs, and for other purposes.

- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 4281) to provide an extension of Federal-aid highway,

4 grams. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
5 are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points  
6 of order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-  
7 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill  
8 and any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-  
9 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-  
10 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
11 member of the Committee on Transportation and Infra-  
12 structure; and (2) one motion to recommit.

13       SEC. 2. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII  
14 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-  
15 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the  
16 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported  
17 on the legislative day of March 29, 2012, providing for  
18 consideration or disposition of a measure extending expir-  
19 ing surface transportation authority.
