

MOTION TO RECOMMIT

OFFERED BY M__ . _____

M__ . _____ moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 3523, to the Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendments:

At the end of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 3. PROTECTING THE PRIVACY OF INTERNET PASS-**
2 **WORDS AND THE CREATIVITY OF THE INTER-**
3 **NET.**

4 Nothing in this Act or the amendments made by this
5 Act shall be construed to—

6 (1) permit an employer, a prospective employer,
7 or the Federal Government to require the disclosure
8 of a confidential password for a social networking
9 website or a personal account of an employee or job
10 applicant without a court order; or

11 (2) permit the Federal Government to establish
12 a mechanism to control United States citizens' ac-
13 cess to and use of the Internet through the creation
14 of a national Internet firewall similar to the “Great

1 Internet Firewall of China”, as determined by the
2 Director of the National Intelligence.

Page 12, line 22, strike “and”.

Page 12, line 25, strike the period and insert a
semicolon.

Page 12, after line 25, insert the following:

3 “(G) the number of Americans who have—
4 “(i) been required by employers, pro-
5 spective employers, or the Federal Govern-
6 ment to release confidential passwords for
7 social networking websites; and
8 “(ii) had personal information re-
9 leased to the Federal Government under
10 this section or obtained in connection with
11 a cybersecurity breach; and
12 “(H) the impact of the information that
13 has been released or obtained as referred to in
14 subparagraph (G) on privacy, electronic com-
15 merce, Internet usage, and online content.
