## MOTION TO RECOMMIT THE BILL, H.R. 836 WITH INSTRUCTIONS

\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 836, to the Committee on Financial Services with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment: In section 3(b), before "shall continue" insert the following: ", and any amounts made available for use under such Program pursuant to subsection (d),". In section 3, strike subsection (d) and insert the following new subsection: 1 (d) Continuation of Program for Members of THE ARMED FORCES, VETERANS, AND GOLD STAR RE-3 CIPIENTS.— 4 (1) Identification of amounts for assist-5 ANCE FOR ELIGIBLE HOMEOWNERS.—Not later than the expiration of the 180-day period beginning on 6 7 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 8 of Housing and Urban Development shall— 9 (A) determine, in consultation with the 10 Secretary of Defense and the Secretary of Vet-

erans Affairs, the amount necessary to provide

1	assistance under title I of the Emergency Hous-
2	ing Act of 1975 (12 U.S.C. 2701 et seq.) to eli-
3	gible homeowners (as such term is defined in
4	paragraph (3) of this subsection); and
5	(B) submit notice of such determination to
6	the Congress that specifies such amount.
7	(2) Authorization of appropriations.—Ef-
8	fective upon the submission to the Congress by the
9	Secretary of Housing and Urban Development of the
10	notice required under paragraph (1), there is au-
11	thorized to be appropriated, for assistance under the
12	Emergency Mortgage Relief Program under the pro-
13	visions of law referred to in subsection (a) of this
14	section only for eligible homeowners, the amount
15	identified in such notice.
16	(3) Eligible Homeowner.—For purposes of
17	this subsection, the term "eligible homeowner"
18	means a homeowner who is—
19	(A) a member of the Armed Forces of the
20	United States on active duty or the spouse or
21	parent of such a member;
22	(B) a veteran, as such term is defined in
23	section 101 of title 38, United States Code;
24	(C) eligible to receive a Gold Star lapel pin
25	under section 1126 of title 10, United States

1	Code, as a widow, parent, or next of kin of a
2	member of the Armed Forces person who died
3	in a manner described in subsection (a) of such
4	section; or
5	(D) such a member or veteran of the
6	Armed Forces who has a service-connected in-
7	jury, or a survivor or dependent of such a mem-
8	ber or veteran of the Armed Forces with such
9	an injury.
