What's New in COLAs Online 3.6 (Industry Members)

March 2, 2012

The following enhancements in functionality and interface are included in Version 3.6 of the COLAs Online system:

- **Enter Grape Varietal(s) Field in COLAs Online** – You may now enter a Grape Varietal(s) field value for COLA applications where Type of Product is “Wine.” The field displays between the Wine Vintage and the Wine Appellation fields on the Create Application Step 2 of 3: COLA Information page:
