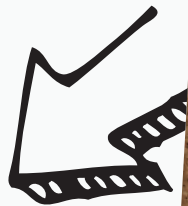

# REMEMBER...

## **Scammers advertise jobs exactly where real employers do**

That includes popular websites and the classifieds.

## **Don't pay for a promise**

They may say they've got a job waiting, or guarantee to place you in a job, if you just pay a fee. But legitimate employers and firms don't ask you to pay for the promise of a job.

## **Information about a job ≠ a job**

Some listing services and "consultants" write ads or phone scripts to sound like they have jobs waiting when they're really only selling information about looking for a job — information generally available for free.

## **You can report job scams to the FTC**
