4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Eric V. King. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA),
6 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am a Power Operations Specialist in the Generation Supply group for the Power Business
9 Line.

10 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

11 A. I received a B.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Idaho in 1988.

12 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

13 A. I have been employed by BPA since 1988. From 1988 until 1998, I served in the Seasonal
14 Planning section as an Electrical Engineer. I was responsible for preparing load/resource
15 studies to determine classes and amounts of power produced by the Federal Columbia River
16 Power System given various ways of operating the system. I prepared each annual Operating
17 Plan for the Pacific Northwest Coordination Agreement (PNCA) and was involved in PNCA
18 contract activities. I also coordinated power planning activities both within and outside of
19 BPA.

20 From 1998 until the present, I have served as a Senior Power Operations Specialist.
21 In this position I am the senior technical advisor to BPA on PNCA matters and on Federal
22 Columbia River Power System operational issues. I coordinate the operation of the Treaty
23 Projects with BPA's Canadian Treaty functions and serve as BPA's technical expert and
24 representative on PNCA-related committees involving other utilities, government agencies,
25 and the public. I serve as the PNCA Contract Committee representative.

1 I was a member of BPA's negotiation team for the renewal of the PNCA and
2 Canadian Entitlement Allocation agreements.
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
