- Stop *Individuals* Who Do *Not* Want to be Stopped
- Find Facts/Truths When People Do Not Want Them Found
- Doing So in a Legally Defensible
 Way for Presentation in Court, as
 Deemed Appropriate


INTERPOL CBRNE Programme Structure

Goals of an Effective Police CBRNE Programme

- 1. Prevention of Initial Attack
- 2. Address Attack
- 3. Prevent Follow-on Attacks
- 4. Bring Conspirators and Perpetrators to Justice in Appropriate Court






