- Proposal elaborated under leadership of INR (Kiev, UA)
- Focused on GUAM (Georgia, Ukraine, Azerbaijan and Moldova) countries

#### On going projects:

- 1- Evaluation and comparison of the performance of available detection equipment relevant to nuclear security (the ITRAP+10 project).
  - Cooperation with US-DHS/DNDO + IAEA
- 2- Creation of a European Radiological/NuclearSecurity Training Programme for the Law Enforcement Community (EUSECTRA) Cooperation with IAEA and US-SLD, support to GICNT IAG

#### **New projects:**

- 1- Support IAEA in improving the IAEA ITDB ( EU/IAEA kickoff meeting Jan 2012)
- 2- Benchmarking of Dispersive codes for the estimation of RDD impact (Project started on Jan 2012)
