Subject: Transportation Management System (TMS)

To all AAFES Suppliers:

AAFES will require all Vendors with FOB Origin terms to convert to the Transportation Management System (TMS) to obtain routing for their freight. Effective 31 December 2007, all routing will flow through the AAFES (TMS) web based system. TMS is a web based routing system that will allow you to release your purchase orders as you are shipping. TMS expedites the routing process allowing you to get carrier assignments faster. TMS will look at all purchase orders being released in a specific area and optimize transportation. Be prepared for your routing to change.

All purchase orders will be sent to you with routing instructions of "partners.aafes.com." You will be required to login to <https://partners.aafes.com> and establish a username and password. Once you have obtained login status contact Denise Montes at 214-312-3122 ([montes@AAFES.com](mailto:montes@AAFES.com)) or Brian Cambra at 214-312-2939 ([cambra@AAFES.com](mailto:cambra@AAFES.com)) so they can establish your TMS link and provide guidance concerning TMS. After TMS link is established, you will be required to login to TMS and release all of your purchase orders. At that point, you will receive an email with routing instructions.
