



## **Annual Inventory Results**

- Inventory Dates:
  - June 30, unless TTB is notified of another date
  - December 31, if reporting annually
- Reported on TTB Form 5120.17 <u>when a</u> <u>complete inventory is taken</u>

## **Annual Inventory Results**

- Bulk Wine Section A
  - Line 9 Inventory Gains
  - Line 30 Inventory Losses
- Bottled Wine Section B
  - Line 5 or 6 Inventory Gains
  - Line 19 Inventory Shortage

Place the figures given on Page 16 onto the blank report — TTB F 5120.17.

## Filing the Report

- Due 15 days after the close of the reporting period
- Filing periods are Monthly, Quarterly, Annually, or as needed
- Not submitted unless reportable operations occurred during period
- May be filed on paper or using Pay.Gov

## Annual and Quarterly Filing

### Annual:

- Must file an annual tax return, if any
- Inventory will not exceed
   20,000 gallons at any
   time
- Written intent is filed with NRC

### Quarterly:

- Must file quarterly tax returns, if any
- Inventory will not exceed 60,000 gallons at any time
- Written intent is filed with NRC

## Compliance Concerns

- Reports are not filed, or are filed late
- Entries do not balance
- Negative entries
- Bottled wine shortages are not taxpaid
- Claims are not filed for excessive bulk inventory shortages
