Colonel (COL) Hisle was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the United States Army Field Artillery in May 1984. After completing the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, he served as a Fire Support Officer, Platoon Leader, and Executive Officer in the 1st Infantry Division from 1985 - 1988. In 1989 he served as a Captain assigned to V Corps Artillery, commanding Bravo Battery, 3rd Battalion, 20th Field Artillery Regiment (Cannon) during combat in Operations Desert Shield/Desert Storm.

COL Hisle served as an Assignments Officer at Field Artillery Branch, PERSCOM, in Alexandria, Virginia from 1992 to 1995. In May 1995 he was selected to serve as the Aide- de-Camp to the Commanding General of the Field Artillery and Fort Sill. As a Major he served with III Corps Artillery as a Fire Support Officer and Deep Operations Fires Chief until 1997. After attending the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, COL Hisle served in the 1st Cavalry Division from 1998 - 2001 as Battalion Operations and Executive Officer for the 1st Battalion, 21st Field Artillery Regiment (MLRS).

As a Lieutenant Colonel, COL Hisle served as an instructor at the Command and General Staff College and in June 2003 he assumed battalion command of the 1st Battalion, 77th Field Artillery Regiment (MLRS).

In June 2005, COL Hisle served as the Deputy Commander for III Corps Artillery at Fort Sill, Oklahoma. From July 2006 - June 2007 he attended Senior Service College as an Army Fellow at the Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, in Boston, Massachusetts, as a Leader Development Fellow in the National Security program. From July 2007 - October 2008 COL Hisle served as a special staff officer for the TRADOC Commander, GEN William S. Wallace, serving as the first Director of the Army Leader Development Program.

From November 2008 - October 2010 COL Hisle commanded the 1st Battlefield Coordination Detachment (BCD) at Davis-Monthan Air Force Base, Arizona, serving as a liaison between the 12th Air Force Commander and US Army South Commander for joint fires and effects. COL Hisle deployed 1st BCD in support of combat operations in the CENTCOM AOR from September 2009 - September 2010, working for the ARCENT CFLCC, coordinating ground and air synchronization for ISAF Joint Command in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM in Afghanistan as well as for USF-I in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM and NEW DAWN in Iraq. From October 10 - May 12, COL Hisle served as the Director of the Joint and Combined Integration Directorate for the Commanding General, Fires Center of Excellence, Major General Dave Halverson, at Fort Sill, OK.

His schools include the Field Artillery Basic and Advance Courses, CAS3, Command and General Staff College, the US Army Airborne School, and he is an Army War College graduate. His decorations include two Bronze Stars, as well as numerous other achievement and combat service awards.
