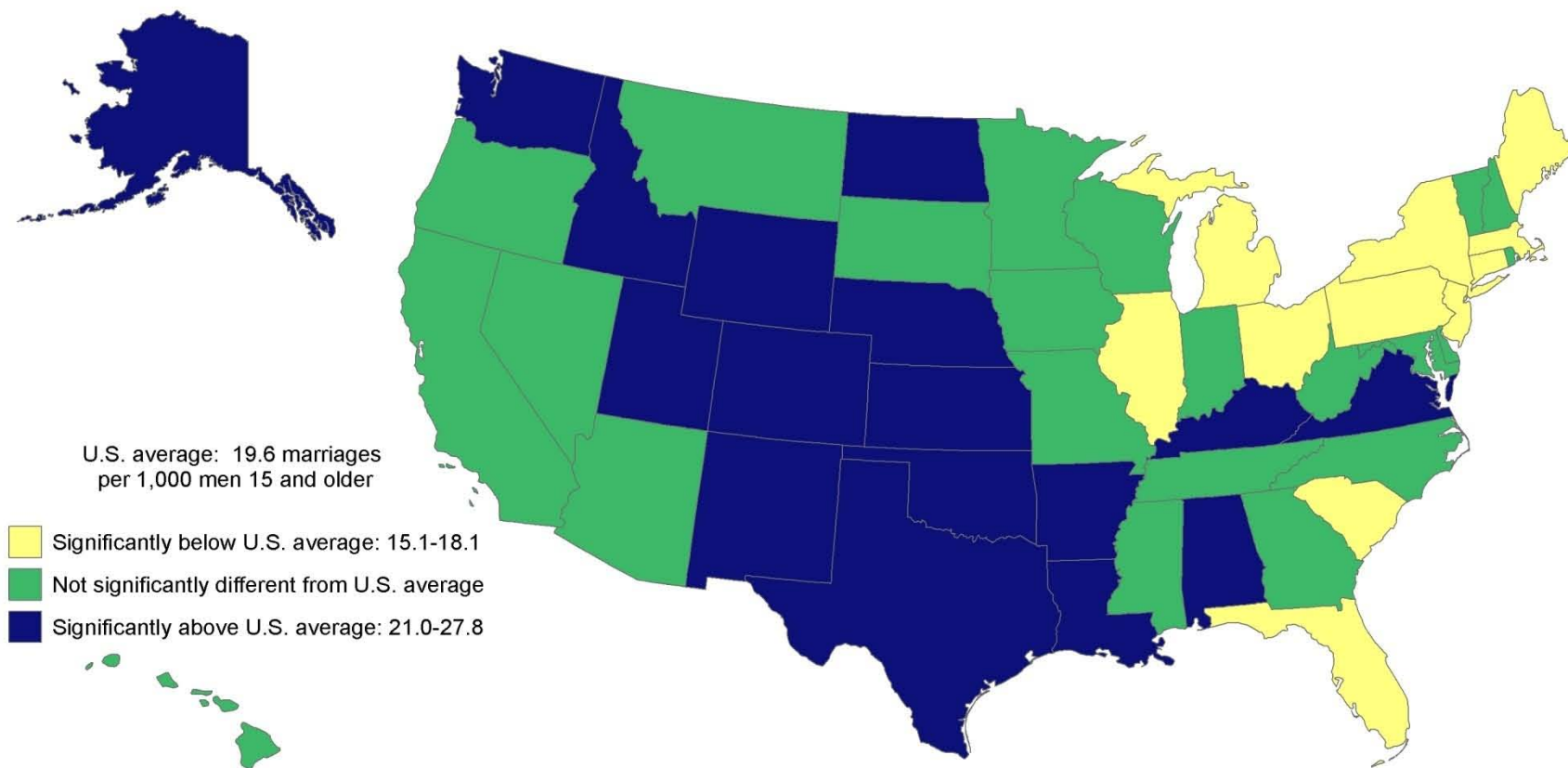
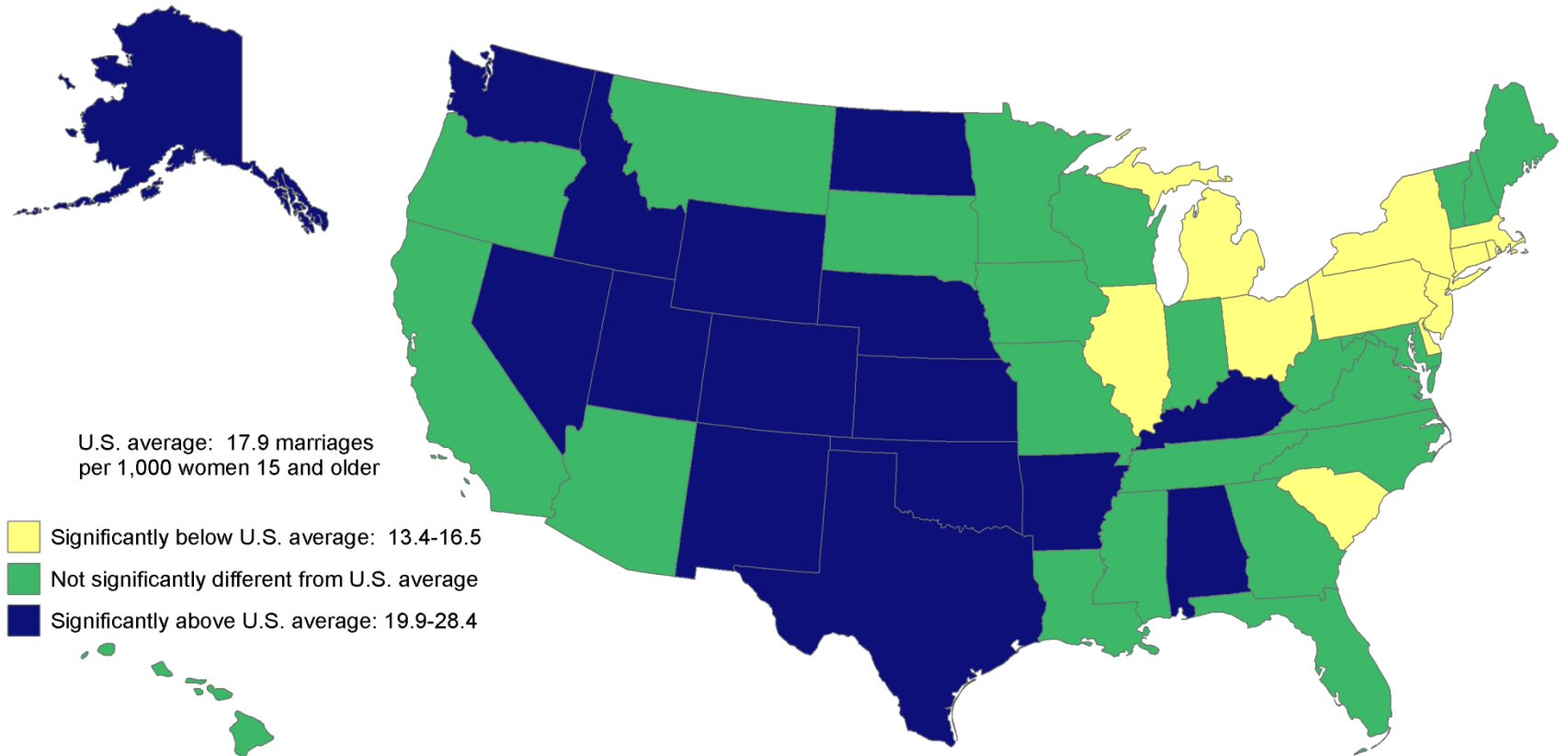


*Figure 1: Marriage rates for men, by state: ACS 2008*



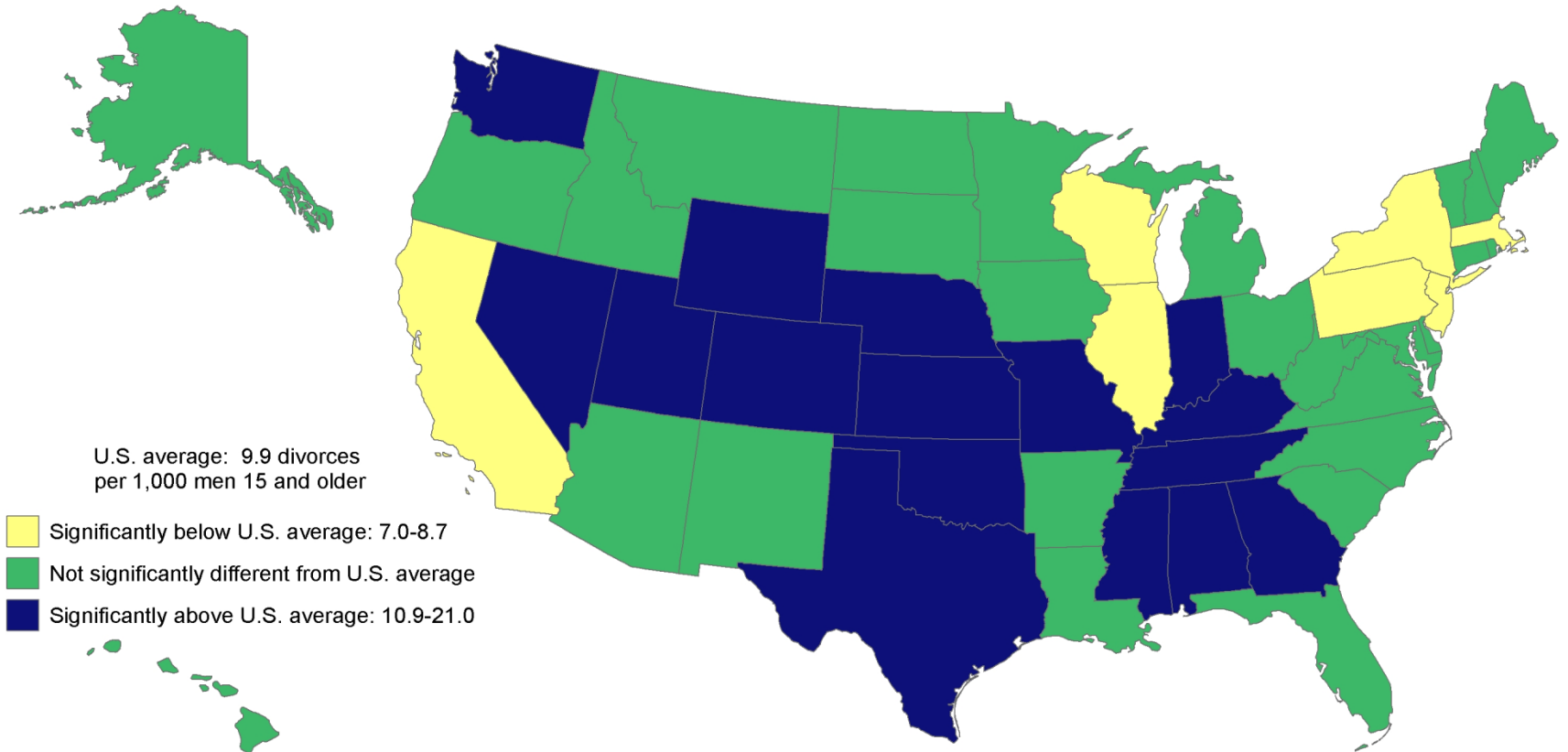

*Figure 2: Marriage rates for women, by state: ACS 2008*



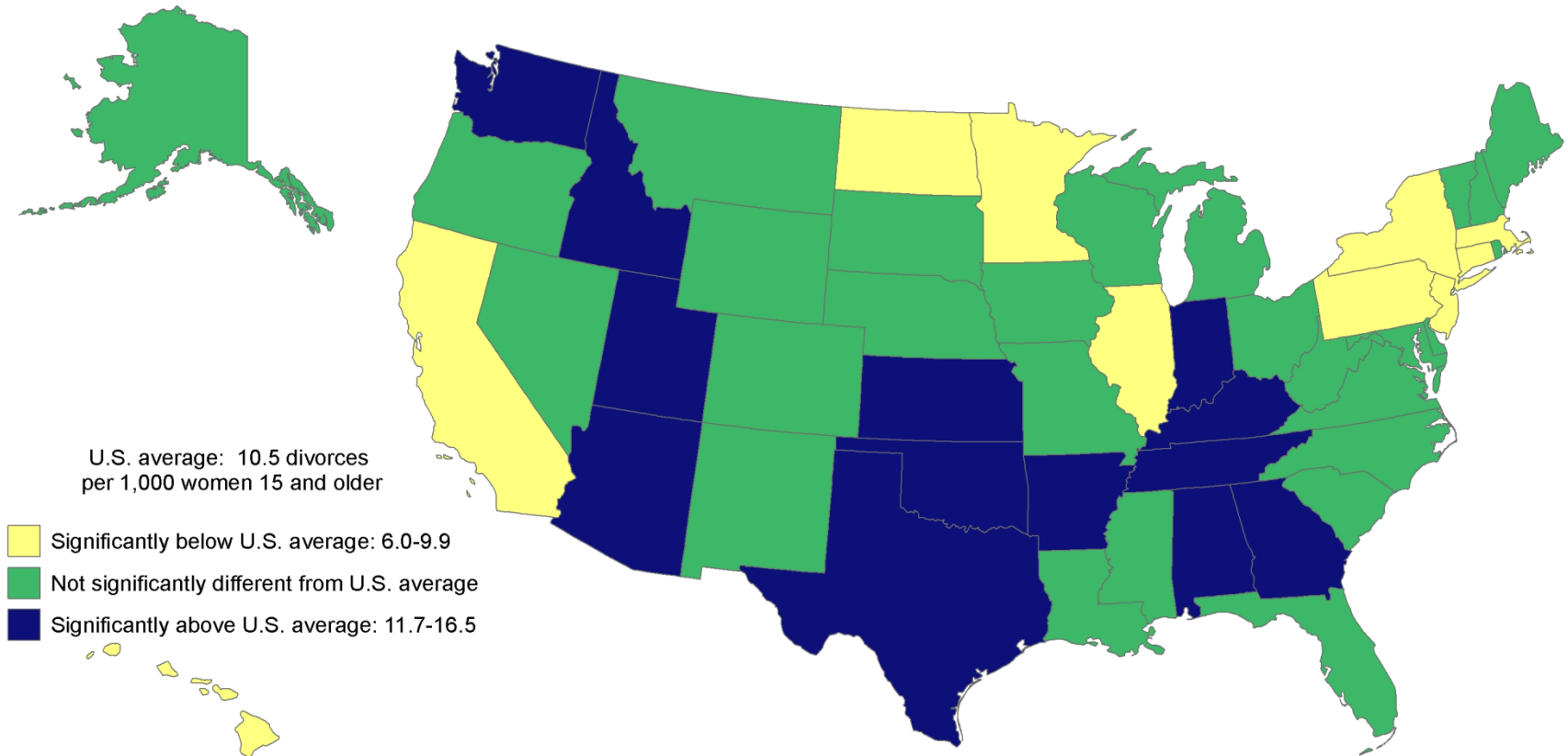

*Figure 3: Divorce rates for men, by state: ACS 2008*



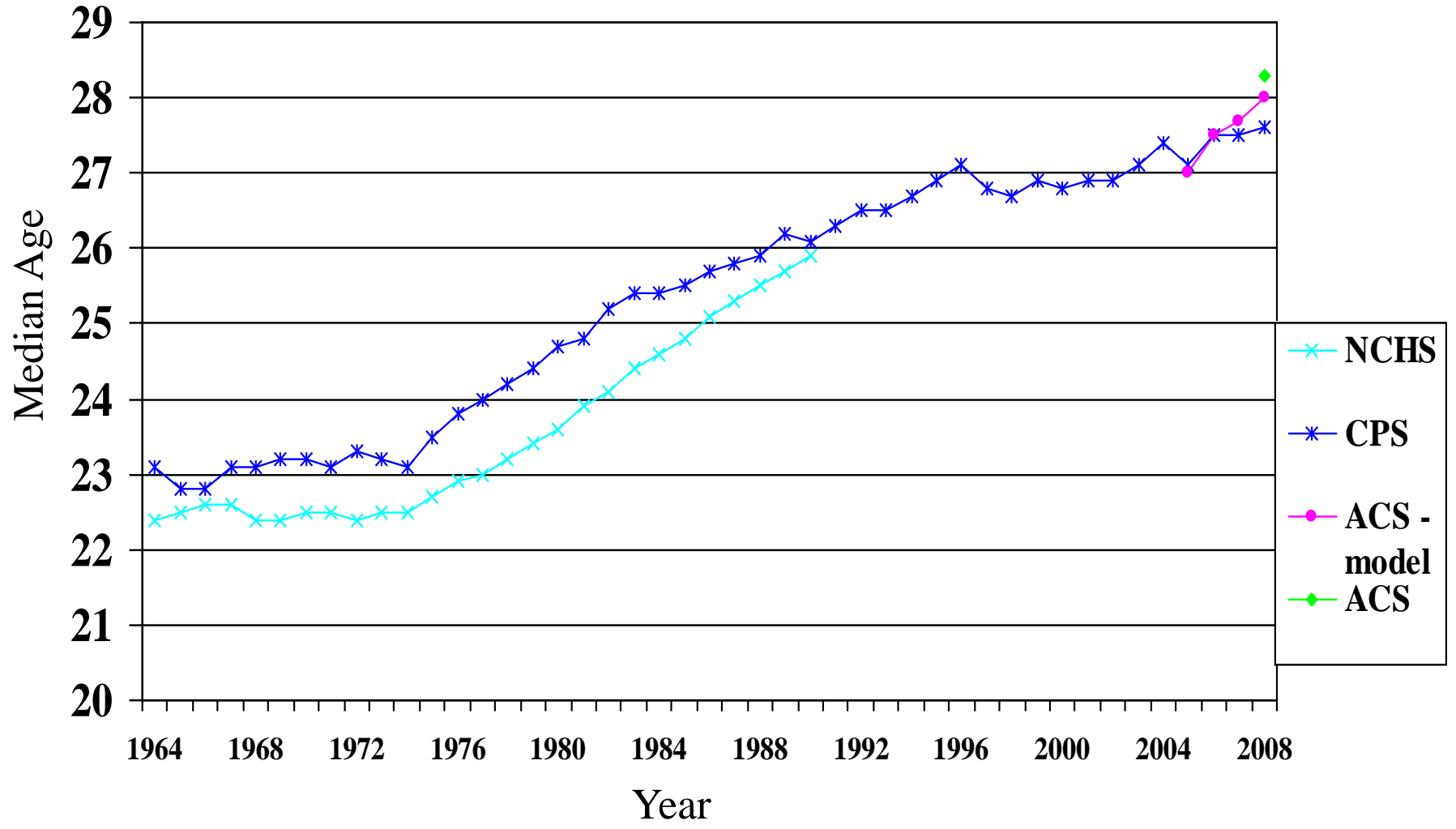

*Figure 4: Divorce rates for women, by state: ACS 2008*



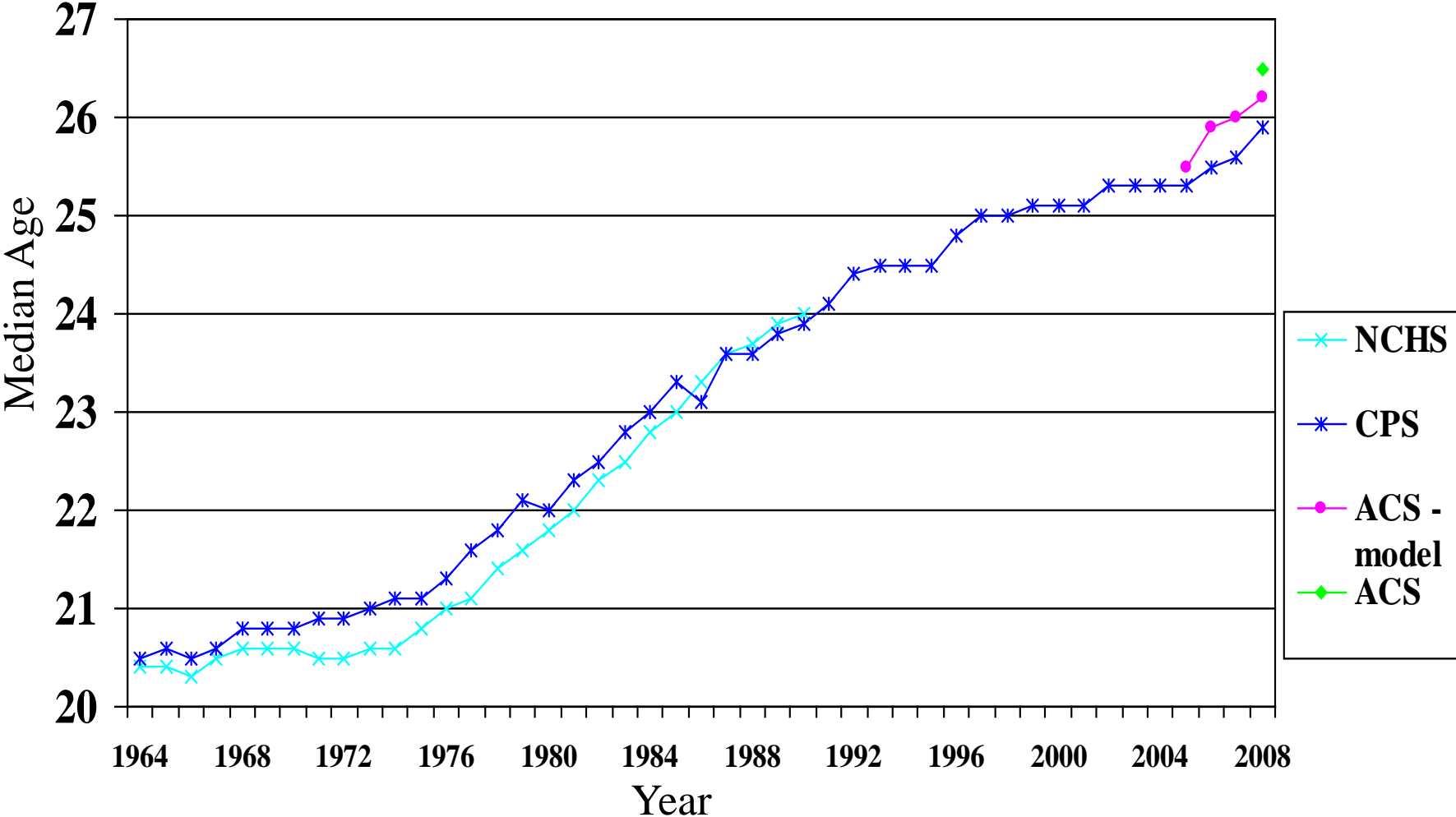

Figure 5: Median age for men with first marriages: NCHS (1964-1990), CPS (1964-2008) and ACS (2005-2008)



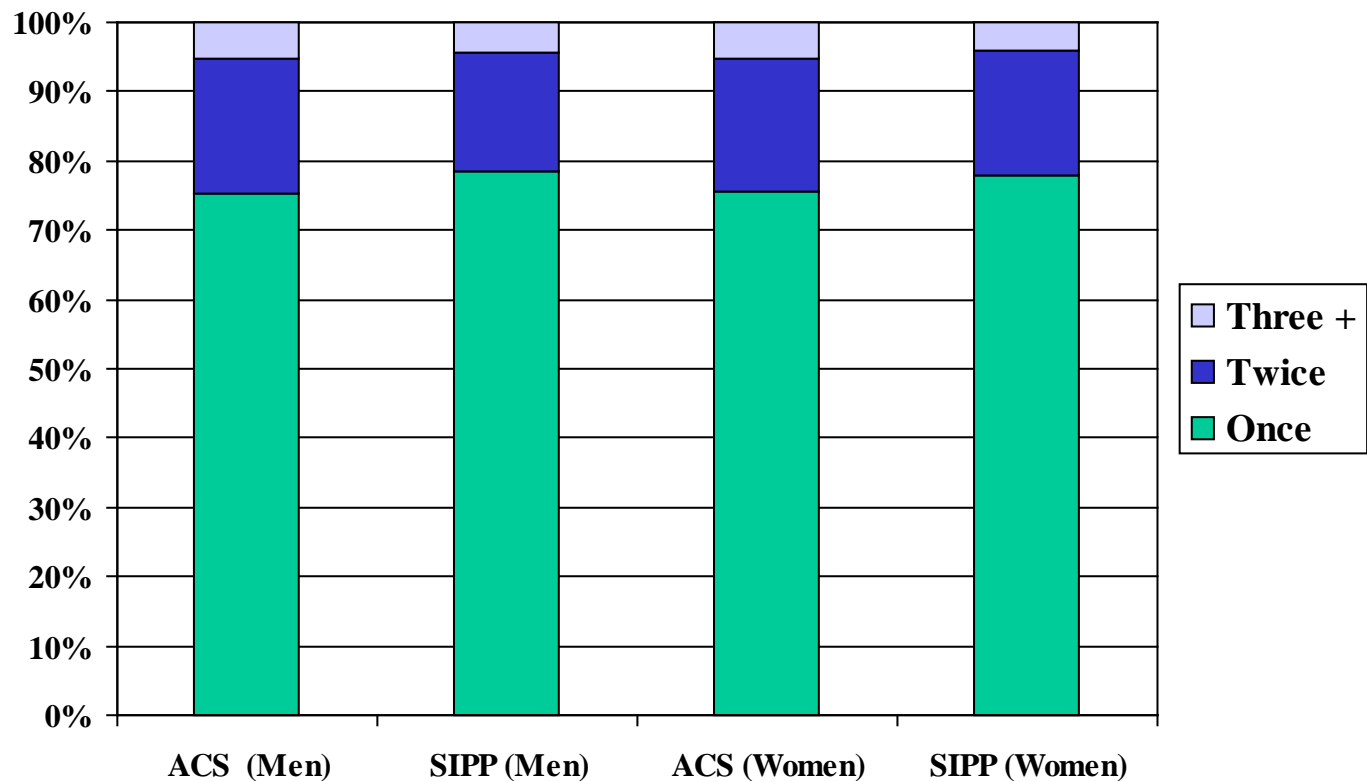
