

ORDER ON MOTION FOR EXTENSION

On October 11, 2002, non-party Weitech, Inc. ("Weitech") filed a motion to extend time for filing a motion for a protective order. Weitech requested an extension of time until five business days after the effective date of any protective order governing discovery material.

On October 21, 2002, a protective order governing discovery material was entered in this matter. This protective order should adequately protect Weitech's interests in the documents that Weitech voluntarily submitted to the Federal Trade Commission. If, upon reviewing the protective order, Weitech continues to feel that its interests are not adequately protected, Weitech may file a motion for a protective order. Accordingly, Weitech's motion is DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
