ORDER

On February 5, 1998, petitioner LEGO Systems, Inc. ("LEGO") filed its Motion to Intervene or, in the Alternative, To Strike or Correct Finding 334 of the Administrative Law Judge's Initial Decision. Pursuant to delegated authority,¹ and after considering LEGO's motion and the issues raised therein, Commissioner Thompson denied the motion, finding LEGO's arguments without merit.
