CERTIFICATE of ELIGIBILITY

This certificate entitles your family to receive up to 20 hours of child care (for each child) when you are within 60 days of your PCS departure or arrival date at Patrick AFB **once you have met the child care program requirements (i.e., current shots,(bring shot record) and give 48 hours notice to the Family Child Care Office)**. This child care will be provided in licensed Family Child Care homes on base or Air Force affiliated homes off base, and paid for by the Air Force Aid Society. You must present this certificate to the Family Child Care Coordinator for placement with a licensed provider participating in this program.)

It is your responsibility to ensure the 20 hour limit is not exceeded.

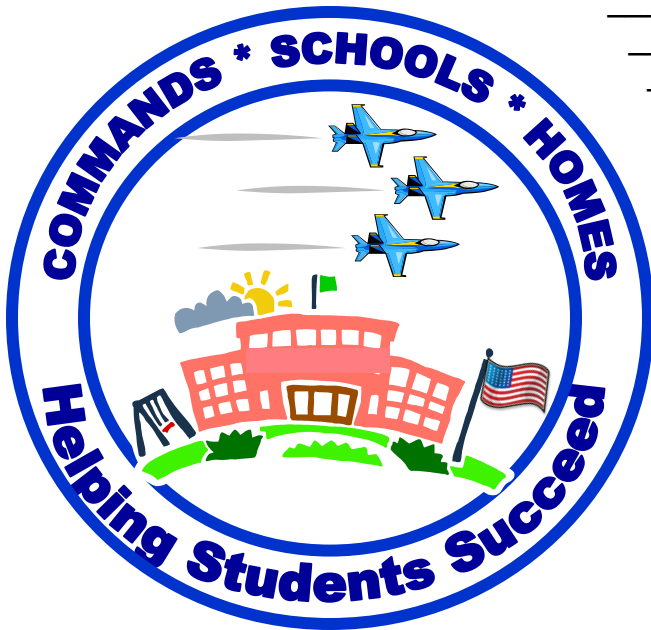

Several school options are offered in our county: attendance area, choice, magnet, charter, virtual, and home schools. Neighborhood School is the school assignment based on the student's home address. Families do not need to complete an application for their children to attend or remain at their neighborhood school. Parents need to contact the school for enrollment requirements. Go to <http://edulog.brevard.k12.fl.us/edulog/webquery/> to find your child's attendance area school.

Choice Schools and Choice Programs offer cutting-edge experiences in math, science, the arts, leadership, technology and creativity through a curriculum unique to that school. Choice schools provide a match between the interests, aptitudes and talents of students and the ideal learning environment. Because Choice Schools and Choice Programs teach to different learning styles, students are able to thrive whether they are visual, auditory or kinesthetic learners. 
