**AMENDED CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 1201 OF
THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT**

Pursuant to Title XII, section 1201 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Pub. L 111-5 (Feb. 17, 2009)) ("ARRA"), I, M. Michael Rounds, Governor of the State of South Dakota (State), hereby certify to the Secretary of Transportation that the State of South Dakota will maintain its effort with regard to State funding for the types of projects in DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA. The attached list of DOT "covered programs" identifies the amount of funds the State plans to expend from State sources from February 17, 2009, to September 30, 2010, for the types of projects under the DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA.

I understand that, if the State of South Dakota is unable to maintain the level of funding identified in this list of the types of projects under the DOT "covered programs" funded under ARRA, the State of South Dakota will thereafter be prohibited by the Secretary of Transportation from receiving additional limitations on obligations for Federal-aid highway and highway safety construction programs that occurs after August 1 for fiscal year 2011.
