The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) hereby requests the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to modify the FY 2007-2010 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) list of Transportation Enhancement (TE) Program projects (Exhibit A-7) to include the attached list of projects designated to receive American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 federal stimulus funding.

#### II. Additional Remarks:


The proposed funding for the identified projects will consist of the new American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 federal stimulus funding. Kentucky is scheduled to receive \$421.1 million of ARRA funding of which \$12.6 million is dedicated to the Transportation Enhancement Program. The federal formula TE funds programmed will become part of the 2006 STIP end of Fiscal Year 2009 "fiscal constraint" recalculations.


