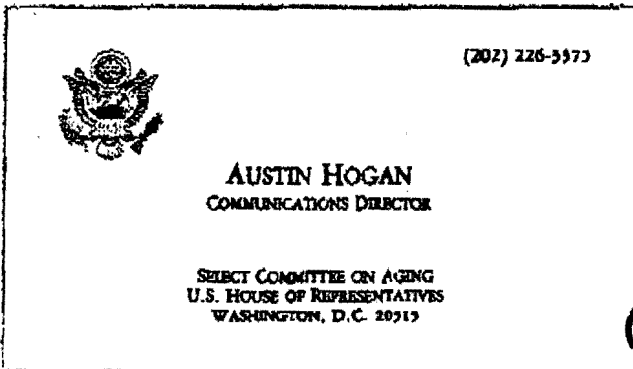

From 1985 through 1992, she was Governor Clinton's Liaison to the National Governors' Association. During this period, she worked closely with the NGA's Washington staff, both during Governor Clinton's Chairmanship and while he was lead Governor on welfare reform, child care and health care reform.
