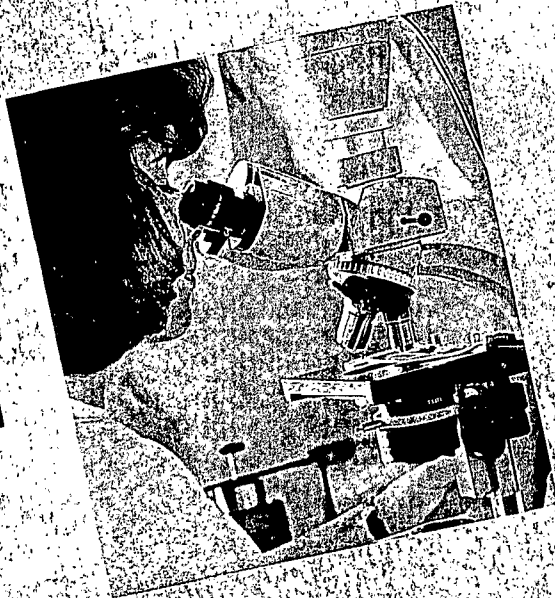


Dear Gary:


