The President would like an indepth briefing on welfare reform which may even turn into a somewhat final decision meeting the week of March 21. I would estimate he needs 1 1/2 hours minimum. It will include about 10 cabinet members and about 22 people maximum.

At this time I am committed to the following speeches which if given enough time I could change gracefully and of course for the President could change on the spur of the moment if necessary:
12 to 1:30 p.m. Monday (21)
1-2 Tuesday (22)
10-11:30 Thursday (24)
2:30 to 3:45 Thursday (24)
12 until 3:30 or so Friday (25)---I'm seeing my daughter off to Portugal...the only event I cannot change.

It is helpful if this meeting can be late afternoon in order to have higher attendance by cabinet but again, they will come whenever. I would like to give them as much notice as possible. There is, again, the possibility this could be only one of two decision meetings and it might be the only one.
