RE: NEH Challenge Grant [OIG-10-01 (DR)]

Dear Ms. Galipault:

After reviewing Kenyon College's June 30, 2009 single audit report, we determined that the current NEH challenge grant entitled "Center for the Study of American Democracy" (was improperly omitted from the Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (SEFA) as required by OMB Circular A-133, *Audits of States, Local Governments, and Non-Profit Organizations* (see attached). Accordingly, this NEH challenge grant (was not considered by the independent auditor (IPA) when selecting the federal programs to be tested as part of the A-133 audit.

OMB Circular A-133, Section 205(e) states that the <u>cumulative</u> balance of federal awards for endowment funds, which are federally restricted, are considered awards expended in <u>each year</u> in which the funds are still restricted. Moreover, the <u>Administration of NEH Challenge Grants</u> manual states that funds deposited into income-earning accounts are to be treated as federal expenditures. Consequently, the full amount of federal funds received from NEH as of June 30, 2009 should have been reported as federal expenditures on the SEFA since these funds are specifically restricted to build an endowment.

Furthermore, we completed a cursory review of the related grant file and determined that three certification reports reflecting in non-federal matching funds have been submitted to NEH. This resulted in the release of in cumulative federal dollars by NEH as of today's date. Now that the total federal "expenditures" exceed the A-133 major program threshold (\$\square\$\text{\$\tex{

Please ensure the College's controller and the outside independent auditors (a line of this matter) are informed of this matter. It's imperative that this deficiency be corrected since the improper preparation of the SEFA and faulty A-133 audit procedures can lead to additional scrutiny by federal auditors, to include our office, and the temporary suspension of federal funding.
