Airlines are now collecting additional passenger information as the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) implements **Secure Flight**, a program developed to allow for uniform watch list matching by TSA to identify known and suspected terrorists.

How will Secure Flight affect me?

Passengers must provide their **full name**, **date of birth**, **gender**, **and Redress Number** (if available)* to airlines to allow TSA to perform watch list matching. Providing the data elements allows Secure Flight to more effectively perform watch list matching, resulting in a better travel experience for passengers.

* Those who encounter misidentification are invited to apply for Redress at www.dhs.gov/trip to help prevent watch list matching misidentifications in the future.
