#### Welcome and Introductions - Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

Ivan DeLoatch, Executive Director, FGDC OS, welcomed participants to the meeting and asked everyone to introduce themselves.

#### Previous Meeting Action Item Review - Arista Maher, FGDC OS

Arista Maher (FGDC OS) reviewed the action items from the previous meeting, noting statuses and resolutions on each.

#### FGDC Business Report - Ivan DeLoatch, FGDC OS

#### [Presentation, PDF]

Ivan gave an update on FGDC Business, including a summary of various FGDC committees' recent decisions and activities. The upcoming Steering Committee meeting on September 20 was discussed, as well as the next National Geospatial Advisory Committee (NGAC) meeting on September 18-19. The most recent Executive Committee (ExCom) meeting took place on August 27, and included discussions on the Geospatial Platform Business Plan and Business Case and A-16 data themes. The next Coordination Group (CG) meeting will take place on October 16. It was noted that the dates for the CG meetings in 2013 have been set and are available on the FGDC website calendar.

# ACTION: CG members who have an interest in serving as the CG Co-Chair are asked to respond to the FGDC Secretariat by September 14.

The next Steering Committee meeting will take place on September 20, and will feature agenda items such as Geospatial Information Sharing, a report out on the NGAC meeting, and discussions on the Geospatial Platform Business Plan and Business Case. The NGAC meeting will be held on the two preceding days. The NGAC nominations are still in progress; a review panel met last week to discuss the potential candidates and make recommendations to the Secretary of the Interior. The recommendations should be approved prior to January 2013. A Geospatial Line of Business/Geospatial Platform update was given, including a status on Managing Partner activities, interagency documents, and PMO tasks.

A status on the NSDI Cooperative Agreements Program (CAP) was also given. The 2013 category descriptions have been posted to the FGDC website. There are a total of 25 possible awards. The official announcement will be posted to Grants.gov by October/November 2012. The FGDC Annual Report is in the editing phase. CG members were thanked for their efforts in contributing to the report. The report should be published by December 2012.

An update on FGDC Standards activities was given. The FGDC OS is continuing its review of CG member agency participation in standards activities, and has updated Chapter 10, Standards Suites for Spatial Data Infrastructure, of the SDI Cookbook. The FGDC Standards Work Group will meet on September 25 to discuss geospatial web service standards. Statuses on the CAP Standards projects were shared with CG members, as well as updates on standards activities in relation to INCITS L1, OGC, and GWG.

#### <u>National Digital Orthoimagery Program (NDOP) Subcommittee Report – Anne O'Connor,</u> <u>Census Bureau</u>

Anne O'Connor gave an update on the recent activities of the National Digital Orthoimagery Program (NDOP) Subcommittee. The NDOP Subcommittee is responsible for developing, promoting, and executing a national strategy for acquisition or development of orthoimagery data for Federal agencies while creating and utilizing partnerships with State, local, tribal, and private organizations. NDOP member agencies include: FSA, USGS, NGA, NRCS, FS, BLM, FEMA, NOAA, NSGIC, NPS, EPA, and Census Bureau. The Subcommittee Chair rotates annually with the transition after the fall meeting.

The Subcommittee most recently met in May 2012. They discussed the NAIP 2012-14 acquisition plan, data distribution including cloud services, and agency updates and subcommittee reports. Their follow-ups include that the Technical Management Subgroup will look into finding an appropriate imagery compression value that will satisfy all programs, and that agencies will continue to look into the potential of cloud services. The Project Management Subgroup held a meeting in July as well.

The Subcommittee has been working on various projects, including the Urban Areas program, which is co-sponsored by NGA and USGS, and is focused on obtaining 1-ft, leaf off imagery, and they hope to maintain a 3-year refresh cycle for all of the urban areas with a 2-year cycle for the top 50 cities. Furthermore, the USGS National Geospatial Program conducted a study on cloud services, with results including reduced costs, and better reliability and performance. NOAA has coordinated with

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USGS to provide access to USGS CLICK LiDAR data from the Digital Coast, and plans to provide access to USGS National Map imagery from the Digital Coast later in FY12. They are working on acquiring better Alaska imagery as well.

The next meeting of the NDOP Subcommittee will take place on October 23-25, 2012 in Salt Lake City, Utah. They plan on discussing NAIP and High Resolution Imagery Program Updates, as well as distribution methods/collaboration, and theme leads responsibilities for A-16 data themes. In the coming months, they hope to work on ways in which to present plans and accomplishments to a wider audience including updating of website, better coordination of imagery and elevation data acquisition investments in Alaska, and cooperative implementation between agencies to reduce the expense associated with hosting and delivering orthoimagery to their collective users.

#### Cultural and Demographic Statistics Work Group Report – Lynda Liptrap, Census Bureau

Lynda Liptrap gave an update on the recent activities of the Cultural and Demographic Statistics Work Group report. The purpose of the Work Group is to promote the collections, use, sharing and dissemination of cultural and demographic geospatially referenced data pertinent to the needs of the nation. They propose a discontinuation of the Work Group due to the elimination of the A-16 theme by the same name. The only current project-- the Cultural Resource Standard-- would be more suitable under the Cultural Resource Theme. Anne O'Connor is following up with Desiree at National Park Service (NPS) to determine whether they are in agreement with this change.

ACTION: Anne O'Connor will follow up with her contact at the National Park Service on potentially moving the Cultural and Demographic Statistics Work Group into a newly created Cultural Resource Standard Work Group. She will report back to the FGDC Secretariat with more information on the proposed Work Group, and the Secretariat will then put together an electronic ballot regarding this change for the CG to vote on.
