This letter responds to the petition submitted by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, dated October 1, 2009, which the U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy received on October 6, 2009. Due to the substantial number of rulemaking activities currently being undertaken by the agency to improve the energy efficiency of both consumer and commercial equipment, we were unable to provide you with an acknowledgement of the agency's receipt of the petition in a more timely manner. We apologize for this situation and regret any inconvenience that this may have caused.

DOE accepts the Commonwealth's petition for filing purposes under Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) 430.42(f). Our acceptance of the petition for filing purposes, however, does not constitute a determination regarding the sufficiency of the petition, nor does it reflect DOE's views as to the petition's merits or the final disposition thereof. Consistent with the requirements under 10 CFR 430.42(a), the Commonwealth is under a continuing obligation to provide any new or newly discovered information relevant to its petition.
