1/ This table summarizes highway-user revenues and their disposition for all levels of government. See Tables SDF and LDF for details on State and local imposts.

2/ Total Federal receipts based on gross tax liabilities and refunds reported by the U.S. Department of the Treasury. Payments attributable to highway users in each State are estimated by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

3/ Amounts shown for each State include only those transfer payments and direct Federal work, which are funded by the Highway Trust Fund's highway-user revenues, rather than Trust Fund interest income, or general funds. See Table FA-21 for full details on Federal funding of highways.

4/ Payments to each State are partially estimated based on each State's percentage of total obligations for transit.

5/ Amounts shown represent total Federal highway-user revenues collected in each State less amounts received by the State from the Highway Trust Fund for highways and mass transportation. The 1994 total is significantly higher than the

1993 total, due to the imposition of an additional 4.3 cent tax on motor fuels dedicated for deficit reduction starting 10/1/93. The Federal government also uses a portion of motor-fuel tax revenue for the Leaking Underground Storage Tank (LUST) Fund. States with negative numbers receive more from the Highway Trust Fund than the amount of collections attributable to those States.

6/ Gross allocations of highway-user revenues to State general funds were reduced by the amount of appropriations for highways from State general funds. See Table DF for details.

7/ Amounts shown represent direct Federal expenditures that can not be attributed to any single State and the net increase or decrease in the Highway and Mass Transit Accounts of the Highway Trust Fund. See Tables FA-21 and HF-10 for more details.
