A beverage labeled and sold as a "Malt Beverage" should contain just that. Allowing producers to substitute the distinguishing characteristic of these beverages (fermented malt alcohol) with other sources of alcohol is dishonest, and would be in complete disregard of consumers' desire for fair and honest labeling.

In summary, I support the proposed "0.5% standard" for FMBs in order to defend the image of what the general public considers beer or malt beverages, and to ensure consistent and honest labeling of such products.
