We operate a business in Cushing, OK that depends on sales of flavored malt beverages. Products like Captain Morgan Gold, Bacardi Silver, and Smirnoff Ice fly off our shelves. I am convinced that the proposed new regulations would sabotage this family of products by making it impossible to produce or too costly to sell. That means a direct hit to my bottom line. I urge you to oppose TTB Notice No.4.
