## U.S. IFR/VFR Enroute Low Altitude Planning Charts

- U.S. IFR/VFR Low Altitude Planning Charts are designed for pre-flight and enroute flight planning for IFR/VFR flights.
- Information includes: low altitude LF/MF and VHF airways and mileages, low altitude navigational facilities, airports with 3,000' hard-surfaced runways or greater, special use airspace areas, cities, state boundaries, time zones, and major drainage.
- Also includes: a mileage table showing great circle distances between major airports.
- Charts have insets that portray areas from Washington, D.C. to Boston, and from Los Angeles to San Diego.
