Big Sky Distributors, LLC supports the proposed rule issued March of this year, which outlined requirements in order for flavored malt beverages to be classified as beer, alcohol from distilled sources can not exceed 0.5%. The adoption of the TTh "0.5% by volume standard" will ensure the integrity of beer and the brewing process.

Beer is a unique product and has been treated differently from other alcohol beverages with regard to regulation and taxation throughout our nations history. The proposed TTB rule is consistent with the historical interpretation of what constitutes beer and other malt beverages, the distinctions between beer and products with higher alcohol contents regarding regulation and federal tax codes. This proposed rule will help maintain an orderly marketplace and avoid costly and confusing disruptions at state levels in terms of licensing, taxation, distribution policies and regulation of beer and other alcohol products.

Beer is not a distilled spirit or a fortified wine and is not produced through those processes. Beer is made through the brewing process. The 0.5% standard will ensure the integrity of beer remains and mandate other producers of alcohol beverages can not attempt to categorize themselves as beer.

Big Sky Distributors supports the TTB giving final approval to the proposed 0.5% standard on FMB's.
