Dear Sir or Madam:

I want to express my support for the U.S. Treasury's Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau proposed rule-making for flavored malt beverages (200 LR-1 36P).

This proposed regulation will clarify that products sold, marketed and taxed as a malt beverage product must be made according to traditional brewing methods and processes. The proposed 0.5% standard will ensure the stability of the retail licensing system in the overall marketplace. A consistent standard will allow wholesalers and retailers to continue to distribute, sell and market flavored malt beverages as they do today.

This proposed regulation will bring about uniformity and prevent each state from having to deal with this issue on a piece-meal basis.
