I am writing to comment on TTB Notice 4, Flavored Malt Beverages (FMBs) and Related Proposals. While I support TTB's efforts to promote uniformity in the regulatory treatment of these products, I would appreciate your agency addressing the cost-benefit analysis when promulgating a final rule.

I am concerned that the Bureau has not provided a cost-benefit analysis of this proposed rule and it seems likely that the FMB industry will bear the costs of implementing these new regulations, should they go into effect. I would, therefore, appreciate TTB addressing any impacts on jobs, competition and federal and state excise taxes in the final rule.

I hope that you will promulgate a rule that causes as little disruption as is necessary to the marketplace and federal revenues. Thank you for addressing my concerns when crafting the final rule on this issue.
