As Chairman of the Public Safety Sub-committee of the Militia, Police and Public Safety Committee in the Virginia House of Delegates, with oversight responsibility for regulating alcohol in regards to public safety in Virginia, I want to express my support for the Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau's proposed "0.5% by-volume standard on flavored malt beverages (FMB)."
